<sup>2</sup> FLINTS (Force Linked Intelligence System) is used to search multiple force data sources. It draws data from a variety of data warehouses and has many search parameters including names, DOB, addresses, vehicle registration numbers. Those searches give access to information such as police incidents, police intelligence, crimes data and stop & search data.
