- How many drivers were caught using their mobile phones while driving?
- How many of the drivers caught were given penalty points?
- How many of the drivers caught were issued with a fixed penalty notice?
- How many of the drivers caught attended a road safety course instead of receiving a FPN?

I am referring to police officer issued tickets ONLY and not safety cameras.
