It depends on the role of the vehicle and the rating of the tyre in question but see below.

Tyre Depth Replacement Policy

Below H rated tyres and tyres fitted to vehicles with NO emergency warning equipment to be changed at 2mm.

H and above rated tyres and vehicles fitted with emergency warning equipment to be changed at 3mm.
