8 of the guns held are conditioned for 'humane dispatch'

How many of the handguns issued for 'humane dispatch' have additional conditions entered onto the holder's FAC?

All of the certificates issued covering humane dispatch have additional conditions entered onto the FAC

What additional conditions (if any) have been entered onto the firearms certificates?

The additional conditions vary depending on the individuals requirements but include vermin/fox control and deer stalking
