It is important to note that there have been a number of restructures , whereby significant functions have moved from NPU responsibility to central departments. Also in November 2016 The neighbourhood Policing Unit reduced from 10 to 8. Birmingham South was incorporated in Birmingham West and Central and Birmingham North was incorporated into Birmingham East.

As part of our change programme for the future we have significantly restructured the force. We have invested in neighbourhood policing and now have more dedicated neighbourhood officers and PCSOs. In order to allow those officers to focus solely on neighbourhood issues, a number of officers have been moved to bigger, force-wide functions like response and investigative roles. It means we can protect neighbourhood policing but flex to address any threat and demand at a force level.
