s2 MHA	Detention in hospital for 28 days for assessment.
s3 MHA	Detention in hospital for up to 6 months for treatment.
s4 MHA	Emergency admission to hospital for 72hrs.
s5(2) MHA	Doctor's power to hold an inpatient for up to 72hrs
s5(4) MHA	Mental health or learning disability nurse's power to hold an inpatient for up to 6hrs if no doctor available.
s6 MHA	AMHP's power to take and convey a patient to hospital under the MHA.
s18 MHA	Power to re-detain someone who is AWOL under the MHA.
s135(1) MHA	Warrant to enter premises and remove someone to a PoS for MHAA assessment.
s135(2) MHA	Warrant to enter premises and return someone to hospital
s136 MHA	Police power to remove someone to a PoS for assessment.
s138 MHA	Power to re-detain someone who has absconded from custody under the MH.
