West Midlands Police are responsible for the following stretches of motorway:

M6 from Junction 4 to Junction 10a (north bound and south bound)
M42 from Junction 4 to Junction 7 (north bound and south bound)

The cameras used in these areas are variable speed cameras.

- 2. Please detail the speed limits that these cameras enforce; in particular any cameras that are actively used to enforce the 70mph limit, whether these are in an area with variable speed limits or not.**

The speed limits enforced are from 30mph to 60 mph.
