

**1) How many times has your force Section 5 of the 1986 Public Order Act in 2014 and 2015?**

In relation to the number of harassment CRIMES we have recorded, Section 5 of that act refers to Home Office counting rules offences:

- 125/09 - Cause Intentional Harassment Alarm Distress
- 125/11 - Fear or Provocation of Violence
- 125/12 - Harassment Alarm Distress
- 125/58 - Racially Aggravated Harassment Alarm Distress
- 125/61 - Religiously Aggravated Harassment Alarm Distress
- 125/82 - Racially/Religiously Aggravated Harassment Alarm or Distress (s5)

**4) If one of your officers is called to a suspected suicide do your officers provide any information to family members and friends of the deceased around bereavement support?**

All Family Liaison Officers are already trained detectives and then have an extra skill of being Family Liaison Officers. This also applies to Traffic Officers, but they have a traffic qualification.

They do not deal with suicides as such, murder or manslaughter as a rule. The homicide service would then offer all victim support.

Any other victims are covered under the Victims Code.
