

2) Is there such an entity such as an 'extreme missing list'?

3) Would an elderly person whose whereabouts have not been known since 11am of a given day, find themselves on such a list, by the evening?

West Midlands Police do not have an extreme missing list, we assess cases as High, Medium or Low risk cases, based on the information around the vulnerability of each person reported. The passage of time someone is missing could be a consideration to increase the risk from say medium to high if factors such as inclement weather and overdue medication were an issue. This would be done at any time that the reviewing officer felt relevant to do so.
