I am writing to ask a few questions about electronic police notebooks / handheld mobile data devices.

I am doing a research on ways to improve the traditional paper notebooks and to seek methods that can streamline the recording of matters in police notebooks. Currently, there are some police forces in the UK applied an app called "Pronto", developed by Airwave. The app is to help the front line officers dealing with the incidents. It replaces the traditional paper notebook into an electronic one which increased the efficiency of policing dramatically. Here are my questions
