

How many WMP ex-employees have been granted their pension between the ages of 55-59 years of age in the past six years to current date broken down to numbers per year and whether non-medical or medical.

CLARIFICATION

I am seeking to know how many ex-employees who had left the force and then been granted their pension subsequently between the ages of 55-59, whereas the previous request was asking how many employees who were leaving the force and had been granted their pension.

We have provided below figures relating to the numbers officers who have resigned before pension entitlement and have deferred pension benefits in the PPS payable from age 60, then are granted payment early due to Ill Health between the ages of 55 – 59.

Deferred pensions brought into payment on ill health grounds is not something we directly record. However, following a manual search of deferred members on PENHIST we have located the following information:
