

1.) How many former officers from your force are in receipt of Injured on Duty (IoD) pensions, as of December 2017?

There are 336 members currently recorded on payroll with an injury pension element of some type.

2.) We can provide data from 01/02/2013, however it is important to note as recording of injury pensions is being made more specific, figures between 2013 and the date of your request are not strictly comparable.

From 01/02/2013, there were 304 members with injury pension elements on payroll

4.) We may provide the total net cashflow for injury awards in 2017 calendar year.

£5,195,075.37 is the total net cashflow for injury awards in 2017 calendar year.

5. The total amount spent on IoD gratuities the one-off awards given to newly injured officers in 2017?

There are three members recorded having started injury awards during the 2017 calendar year. The total of their payments is £31,189.27.

6. The single highest gratuity awarded in 2017?

The largest single payment was £14,178.39.

7.) Interpreting this as a request for the amount of the largest annual injury award payment at the date of your request.

The amount of the largest annual injury award in payment at current this is £35,405.24 per annum.

8.) What age of the youngest, and the oldest, current recipient of an IoD pension?

As at 29/12 / 2017 .The youngest recipient is 35, the oldest recipient is 89 years old.
