### **Do West Midlands Police deploy GPS tags to manage offenders in your IOM programme?**

Yes, below is the West Midlands Police footprint with the Ministry of Justice statutory tagging pilot, voluntary tagging are local arrangements through local authority funding, not West Midlands Police.

West Midlands Police (WMP) is one of eight national forces that have been involved in the Ministry of Justice GPS tagging pilot which commenced in March 2017 and concludes on 31 March 2018.

### **If so how many tags do West Mids currently have?**

West Midlands Police currently has 10 under the pilot scheme and 22 under the Voluntary tagging scheme through local authority arrangements.

### **How many are currently deployed (presuming that not all that are owned/leased are deployed)?**

West Midlands Police currently has 4 deployed under the pilot scheme and 9 under the Voluntary tagging scheme through local authority arrangements.

### **Were these commissioned through a transparent procurement process?**

They were not procured by West Midlands Police

### **When does the contract for their deployment come up for renewal?**

The contract is not being renewed. The pilot concludes on the 31 March for all 8 forces including WMP.
