

Circumstances of arrest Aircraft

1. pic boarded flight from [REDACTED] on this journey [REDACTED] was noted to be drunk, became verbally abusive during flight to passengers and cabin crew who alerted airport police. Flight met on arrival and officers shown to PIC seat and [REDACTED] demeanour showed officer's [REDACTED] was intoxicated and unsteady on [REDACTED] feet had to be helped off the aircraft and arrested.
2. [REDACTED] states officers alerted to an [REDACTED] where the captain had radioed ahead of a scheduled destination, but emergency landing, due to drunken and disorderly person aboard. Captain of flight requesting police assistance. Plane safely landed. Officers boarded the aircraft having been called to the plane from the cockpit. This PIC was out of [REDACTED] seat and walking down the aisle towards the police non-aggressively. All other passengers had been told to remain seated. The Arresting Officer could smell alcohol on the PICs breath. Having had reported to [REDACTED] that PIC had been disorderly prior to landing, the PIC was arrested suspicion drunk and disorderly. PIC escorted off aircraft. Upon speaking to PIC, [REDACTED] Alternatives to arrest considered, but necessary to investigate the allegation of D & D aboard plane.
3. [REDACTED] states PIC arrested for being drunk aboard an aircraft. [REDACTED] from [REDACTED], reported a disruptive passenger aboard. Aircraft landed safely on schedule. Police Officers boarded the plane. Spoke to aircrew. They reported this PIC had been drinking alcohol during the flight, and deemed it necessary to stop serving [REDACTED] due to [REDACTED] intoxication. PIC was verbally abusive to staff. [REDACTED] Upon landing PIC remained standing ignoring safety instructions of the cabin crew. Officers went to the rear of the plane to this PIC now seated at seat [REDACTED] PIC was intoxicated, slurring [REDACTED] speech, refusing requests to leave the plane. Officers took hold of PIC and escorted [REDACTED] off plane. On the airside tarmac, the PIC [REDACTED] PIC eventually got up and sat in rear of police van.
4. PIC arrested for an offence of being drunk on an aeroplane. Officers received a call from airport control that a [REDACTED] was drunk and abusive on board [REDACTED] Officers attended [REDACTED] airport and spoke with the aircraft commander who identified the pic and stated that the pic had consumed alcohol to the point whereby it had to be confiscated from [REDACTED] That [REDACTED] failed to comply with directions from aircraft staff, that [REDACTED] was abusive to staff and that [REDACTED] Officer spoke with pic, and could smell intoxicating liquor [REDACTED] Arrested for the offence.
5. AO states following a call from the Captain of an [REDACTED] officers attended the aircraft where crew advised that the PIC [REDACTED] was intoxicated and had been fighting with a person now known [REDACTED] This had caused alarm among other passengers. Officers boarded the aircraft and could smell alcohol on the PIC [REDACTED] The facts were established and [REDACTED] was arrested.
6. AO states following a call from the Captain of [REDACTED] officers attended the aircraft where crew advised that the PIC, [REDACTED] was intoxicated and had been fighting with a person now known [REDACTED] This had caused alarm among other passengers. Officers boarded the aircraft and could smell alcohol on the PIC [REDACTED] The facts were established and [REDACTED] was arrested.

<p>7. Cabin crew from an [REDACTED] that during the safety demonstration the pic was shouting and being disruptive stopping other passengers from hearing what was being said. [REDACTED] member of cabin crew tried to give advice where the pic [REDACTED]</p>
<p>8. Pic was argumentative with [REDACTED] sat next to [REDACTED] on the aircraft – [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]</p>
<p>9. AO states airport officers were notified of inbound [REDACTED] was due in and had a disruptive passenger on board who had been abusive towards cabin crew staff. Officers boarded the aircraft on its arrival. The PIC was pointed out by staff as the offender and stated [REDACTED] been intoxicated throughout the flight and had been abusive to cabin crew members at one point [REDACTED] Officers noted the PIC was intoxicated and arrested [REDACTED]</p>
<p>10. Officers were directed to [REDACTED] to reports of a disruptive passenger and whilst on the flight another passenger has knocked into Pic's seat - Pic has got up and started shouting and swearing even though the other passenger has apologised and staff have moved pic to another seat but [REDACTED] has become abusive to them and threatened [REDACTED] in the presence of young children and families. Pic has eventually sat down but continued to be abusive to staff and passengers - As a result captain of the aircraft called ahead to Police to meet aircraft .Aircraft was met by Police and Picv taken off and arrested.</p>
<p>11. [REDACTED] states PIC arrested suspicion drunk aboard an aircraft. Officers were advised that the pilot of an [REDACTED] was calling ahead to [REDACTED] to ask for assistance regarding a drunken disorderly passenger aboard the aircraft, [REDACTED] Aircraft arrived safely. Officers boarded plane at the stand. Spoke to cabin crew. They identified this PIC as having displayed drunken behaviour aboard the plane causing distress to passengers and crew. [REDACTED] Officers spoke to PIC aboard aircraft. PIC refused to leave. Officers saw signs of intoxication, eyes glazed, and smell of intoxicants on breath, speech slurred. PIC became abusive. PIC had to be restrained and forcibly removed from aircraft. Once off, handcuffed to rear, as was struggling. Alternatives to arrest considered, but given disorderly behaviour.</p>
<p>12. Arrested for being disruptive on an Aircraft - Airport officers were directed to [REDACTED] to reports of [REDACTED] on board officers have met the aircraft and spoken with staff who stated that this pic has been drinking heavily at the bar and had become increasingly intoxicated and started swearing and shouting with another passenger who had family – [REDACTED] was warned about [REDACTED] behaviour by staff – [REDACTED] was warned about his conduct by staff and [REDACTED] by staff and staff feared this would continue on landing. . Both arrested.</p>

<p>13. Pic was a passenger on board a [REDACTED] whilst in flight pic consumed a [REDACTED] upset to passengers and cabin crew alerted the captain and the police were requested to attend on the aircraft arrival. Officers and passengers approached officers visibly upset at pic's actions and cabin crew informed officers of the pic's behaviour on board and [REDACTED] arrested for being drunk and disruptive behaviour on an aircraft. During transportation pic continued being abusive and was drunk and stated [REDACTED]</p>
<p>14. Officers called to attend [REDACTED] their request of [REDACTED] Captain requested attendance in regards to a drunk and abusive [REDACTED] On attendance the [REDACTED] had been taken from the aircraft and was in [REDACTED] Pointed out by member of staff and on approach officers saw [REDACTED] was intoxicated and unsteady [REDACTED] and eyes glazed. PIC started swearing and said [REDACTED] Officers informed by staff that [REDACTED] was drunk and abusive and threatening towards other passengers. PIC warned several times about [REDACTED] but continued, causing concern for the safety and wellbeing of the other persons in the aircraft. PIC arrested.</p>

<p>16. [REDACTED] states officers were called to an aeroplane [REDACTED] Report of drunken person on board. Plane had left the stand, and on runway, ready for take-off. This PIC was seated in the [REDACTED] brought PIC to waiting police officers. On speaking to PIC, extremely intoxicated, smell of alcohol, unsteady on feet, eyes glazed, and pupils dilated. Drugs search conducted. Nothing found. PIC arrested for being drunk on board the aircraft. Alternatives to arrest considered, but given the level of intoxication, duty of care required to look after PIC, and promptly expedite any charge.</p>
<p>17. Officers called to [REDACTED] to a report of a disruptive passenger. Enquiries with cabin crew who identified PIC in [REDACTED] & was highly intoxicated. Officers went to offload PIC from aircraft, PIC was highly intoxicated & unable to stand & was helped from plane. PIC arrested for aviation offence of drunk on aircraft.</p>
<p>18. Officers called to [REDACTED] to a report of a disruptive passenger. Enquiries with cabin crew who identified PIC in [REDACTED] & was highly intoxicated. Officers went to offload PIC from aircraft, PIC was highly intoxicated & unable to stand & was helped from plane. PIC arrested for aviation offence of drunk on aircraft.</p>
