We are in need of data to help us understand what happens to young people after being reported to the police for the following online harmful sexual behaviour offences:

* 86/2 Take/make/distribute indecent photogrtaphs or (S) pseudo-photographs of childern

* 86/10 Possession of an indecent or pseudo-photograph (S) of a child

*86/11 Possession of extreme pornographic images (S) an act which threatens a person's life

*86/12 Possession of extreme pornographic images - an (S) act which results, or is likely to result, in serious injury to a person's anus, breats or genitals

*86/13 Possession of extreme pornographic images - an (S) act which involves sexual interference with a human corpse (necrophilia)

*86/14 Possession of extreme pornographic images - (S) person performing an act of intercourse or oral sex with an animal (dead or alive)

86/15 Possession prohibited images of children

86/16 Possess an extreme pornograhpic image portraying (S) rape

86/17 Possess an extreme pornograhpic images (S) portraying assault by penetration.
