

**1. How many 'close pass' cycling incidents have been reported to this force in 2019?**

388

**2. Of those incidents in point 1 how many have resulted in the driver of the vehicle being prosecuted for a close pass?**

289 were deemed worthy of police action and progressed as such.

**3. Of those incidents in point 1 how many went to court with an unsuccessful prosecution for a close pass?**

Court and prosecution information is not routinely fed back into our systems. Therefore, researching each individual case would exceed the appropriate limit (FOIA, s.12).

**4. Of those incidents in point 1 that didn't receive a prosecution, how many were because there were no independent witnesses?**

The reporting scheme for close pass incidents involves the submission of dash / head cam footage; all of these incidents were reported with this footage, therefore no independent witnesses were required.

**5. Of those incidents in point 1 how many were dismissed as 'acceptable pass'?**

99 submissions were not proceeded with as they were not considered to be a close pass.
