AC has requested that the IAG groups should be able to see the Body worn footage from the recent arrest so that IAG groups can feed into the community a true reflection.

██████████ teams were busy with Op Forecast, they have trialled playground engagement with school children but was not as successful as he would have liked. ██████████ explained that he would like to create a questionnaire for the schools for all children to complete in regards to Knife crime ██████████ suggested that he work with the school to compose the questionnaire so that they get the best out of the children when completing it. The teams have also being included in reassurance patrols around the Mosques and have received a good reception.

Hodge Hill █

Connect and build work across different areas of the constituency continues and teams have been actively recruiting for WMNOW and numbers are rising well.

█ there have been 4 shootings █ work around this is continuing. Teams have been active with the section 60 in place. Referrals into the Princes Trust program to assist with tackling knife crime. The Cadet Programme is doing really well and we are hoping to extend this into another two schools across Hodge Hill Constituency.

Teams have been involved in the schools protests only to stop any breaches of the piece, the local councillor is arranging meeting and will be working with the parents and the school and we are happy to support this but not lead on it.

Teams and I have been involve in reassurance patrols around the local mosques.

█
Continue to work on NHW / SW building capacity within the community. Youth world Café to assist in intervention and prevention. We have been working with Starbank School assisting in creating positive role models.

Teams have been educating children in school about knife crime, we are looking at ways we can educate youths through ongoing groups.

█ currently 5 males in prison but more work is being done to catch and convict outstanding offenders.

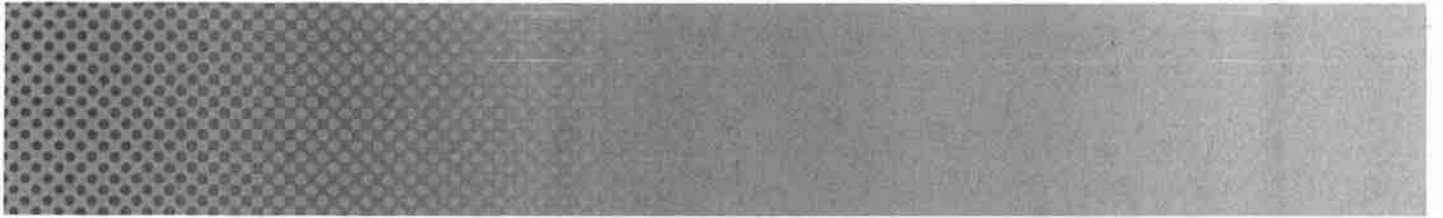
