Presentation on (Operation Guardian Model) [REDACTED]: Project Guardian is a two year project to tackle serious violence in the under 25s, with an emphasis on knife crime.

The four strands of Project: GUARDIAN are

- Suppression
- Intelligence



- Investigation
- Diversion

There will be leads for each of the four strands, helping to bring better ways of working, developing deeper understanding and encouraging premium standards – with as much of it coming from improvements and upholding of standards as from additionally or funding.

The force's response has been to create a two year project – Project Guardian – with [redacted] appointed as the project's senior responsible officer.
