Cost on the location as some locations are just the street, with no town or they record the town in the wrong location on the paperwork, so each record would need to be assessed to accurately evaluate the location to Coventry or Birmingham.

To evaluate the locations exceeds costs as there are in excess of 40000 records.

Could you please disclose how many people were fined due to or charged with “driving using a mobile phone” in Coventry and Birmingham between 1 July 2019, and 30 June, 2020?

467 total in Coventry and Birmingham of which 156 were prosecuted; 277 paid fine and licence endorsed; 34 attended a retraining educational course

Cost on the location as some officers just put the street, with no town or they record the town in the wrong location so each record would need to be assessed to accurately evaluate the location to Coventry or Birmingham.

To evaluate the locations exceeds costs as there are 467 records.
