

Please can I be provided with the following information relating to electric scooter trials for the year 2020:

- How many injuries have there been to riders of hired electric scooters on the trial?
- How many injuries have there been to a victim of someone on a hired electric scooter?
- How many hired electric scooters on the trial have been stolen?
- How many electric scooters on the trial have been damaged?
- How many crimes have been committed on the hired electric scooters on the trial?
- How many people have been charged for committing a crime on a hired electric scooter?

**The above information is not available in an easily retrievable format. Firstly we would need to identify scooters which were included in the trial and even if that could be done it would be difficult to know if a crime such as a robbery for example involved and e-scooter, the only way to do this would be to conduct a manual search of all crimes, this would exceed the FOI time limit.**

- How many people have been fined for riding a hired electric scooter whilst underage?
- How many people have been fined for drunk-driving a hired electric scooter?

**We haven't had any notices in relation to being underage, this would fall under the offence of driving otherwise than in accordance with a licence.**

**Drunk driving, as with driving a car when under the influence, is not a fixed penalty offence, therefore we don't hold any data regarding fines in relation to this.**
