

It has been widely reported that PCSO Andy Pope recently achieved his 2000th identification from CCTV:

1. How many of these identifications resulted in an offender being brought to justice (charged or cautioned)?

From a total of **2117** identifications to date please see the following breakdown:

- A total of **871** arrests
- A total of **158** Voluntary Interviews conducted
- A total of **180** warning letters issued for ASB identifications
- A total of **809** charges/cautions
- A total of **74** Community Resolutions/Restorative Justice
- A total of **26** still pending from recent identifications.

That means that in total **1209** of the identifications resulted in **Arrest/Voluntary Interview/Warning Letters** and **883** resulted in **Charge/Caution or Community Resolution/Restorative Justice**.
