

Q1 Between the period of March 1st 2020 – March 31st 2021, how many missing person cases (specifically women ages 16-65) reported in this period, remain unsolved?

There were 3192 missing person cases (specifically females aged 16-65) in the date parameters set. There were 3158 found records in the same period with the same parameters. This would suggest there are 34 which have been transferred, inactive, closed as doesn't meet definition of missing or still open, however in order to identify the 34 records, all 3192 records would have to be manually reviewed which would exceed the FOI time limit.

Q2 Please also provide the ethnicity and age of each case

Again without reviewing each case we are unable to answer this. What we can provide is the breakdown of ethnicity if specified for the missing and found cases shown below.
