3) What were the reasons for these closure orders

The court was satisfied:

- (a) that a person had engaged, or (if the order was not made) was likely to engage, in disorderly, offensive or criminal behaviour on the premises, or
- (b) that the use of the premises had resulted, or (if the order was not made) was likely to result, in serious nuisance to members of the public, or
- (c) that there had been, or (if the order was not made) was likely to be, disorder near those premises associated with the use of those premises, and that the order was necessary to prevent the behaviour, nuisance or disorder from continuing, recurring or occurring.

Offences may include drug supply, prostitution, and related criminal and Anti-social behaviour etc.

4) How many of these closure orders were for repeat offenders ie people who had been subject to a closure order before
