*\*Please note, it is not West Midlands Police force policy to use Community Resolutions at the scene of a Domestic Incident. In this force, Community Resolutions are used post investigation to lever offenders into a rehabilitative intervention such as CARA or the Alcohol Related Domestic Abuse Course. They are used predominantly where the victim will not engage with the CJS.*

**Police Restorative Justice Team Figures**

There are no records kept by the force for level 1 RJ as this is conducted at the time on the street RJ.

It is recorded next to the figures if it is anything other than level 2 RJ.

Triage is when the case is reviewed and call made to victim as DA is victim lead following a referral into the RJ team.
