1. Please confirm the names of the teams.

2. Please confirm the percentage of staff within those teams who have undertaken any course in relation to emotional domestic abuse.

See attached spreadsheet Tab1. You will note that some teams have done more than 100% training and this is because the MLE modules formed part of essential training and some of them also were pre-reads for other courses and so officers have done them more than once. Data relates to the period January 2015 to the end of June 2022.

3. Please confirm the names of the courses.

A number of courses/modules cover the term 'emotional domestic abuse' and includes all the training under the Sentinel programme, as well as being incorporated in student programmes and Detective programmes, now and in the past. Tab2 of the attached spreadsheet lists all of the courses which a search of our systems returned.

4. Please confirm the specific topics covered within those courses.

Tab3 of the attached spreadsheet provides course objectives for a small number of the courses. Information with regard to current student programmes however is held by Staffordshire University and all other modules are the MLE (Managed Learning Environment) MLE or old NCALT (National Centre for Applied Learning Technologies). Therefore, as per questions 6-10 you might wish to contact the College of Policing and Staffordshire University to see if they are able to assist in providing you with the information you require.

5. Please confirm whether those courses are compulsory or voluntary.

All courses are mandatory and some specialist courses are dependent on role - All officers receive mandatory domestic abuse training in line with The College of Policing Guidance and National Legislation.
