The request relates to the number of electric vehicles in your fleet and how they are charged.

1.How many electric vehicles does your police force currently have in its fleet? Please break down by make/model and state how many of each there are.

41 EV's total. 1 e-208 Peugeot, 33 Corsa-e, 7 e-Expert van Peugeot.

We currently have an additional 17 Corsa-e on order and waiting delivery.

2.What was the total cost of purchasing these electric vehicles?

This information is exempt by virtue of the following exemption

3.How many police stations with vehicle facilities does your force have?

13 sites.

4.How many of your police stations with vehicle facilities are equipped with electric vehicle charge points?

Currently 52 charge point across the Force.

5.How many of your police stations with vehicle facilities have electric vehicles stationed at them?

13 sites.

6.How many of your police stations with vehicle facilities have both electric vehicle charge points fitted and electric vehicles stationed at them?

As above

7.What is the total number of electric vehicle charge points at police stations with vehicle facilities in your force's area?

52 as above. 7.4 and 22kWh charging points.

8.Does your force have a policy for charging electric vehicles and, if so, what is it? For example, are these vehicles charged on-site at police stations or are public chargers used?

Yes, Environmental Strategy board.

Fleet is working with internal partners to make the move to an EV fleet, however this will take time to make the switch.

The infrastructure needs to be put in place (additional charge points) and this will depend on any spare capacity at our property.

All our EV's are only charged at our buildings, currently there are no provisions to charge vehicles at public charging points.
