Ded/SIR Paid (Damages) - Damages = payments to injured party - this is physically the money paid to the claimant, the reference to Ded/SIR Paid relates to where the money has come from – Ded/SIR is another word for policy excess – and we have paid this as payment falls within policy excess

Ded/SIR Paid (Def. Costs) - Def costs = Force legal costs to defend

Prf Costs = Legal cost for claimant - Pltf Cost Costs are claimant costs, but the system still uses the old reference as Plaintiff for Claimant

Please note: For cases that are still on-going, payments may have been made on an interim basis and compensation claims may be ongoing even if payment has been made.

The total figure (number of claims) is the number of claims with a payment made during that year. There could be more than one payment made (more often than not there is – we pay the claimant and the claimant solicitors in close proximity).
