

I would like to request the following information for West Midlands Police, since 2018:

- a) The number of Police Officers and Police Staff who have failed drug tests.
- b) The number of Police Officers and Police Staff who have tested positive for androgenic-anabolic steroids (AAS) including designer steroids, prohormones and designer prohormones. Such as, but not limited to, the ones listed below:

- Boldenone undecylenate (Equipoise)
- Fluoxymesterone (Halotestin)
- Mesterolone (Proviron)
- Methandienone (Dianabol)
- Methenolone enanthate (Primobolan)
- Methyltestosterone (Virilon)
- Mibolerone (Cheque)
- Nandrolone decanoate (Deca Durabolin)
- Nandrolone phenpropionate (Durabolin)
- Oxandrolone (Anavar, Oxandrin)
- Oxymetholone (Anadrol)
- Stanozolol (Winstrol)
- Testosterone cypionate (Depotest)
- Testosterone enanthate (Andro-Estro)
- Testosterone propionate (Testex)
- Trenbolone acetate (Finajet)

- c) The number of Police Officers and Police Staff who have been discharged from duty due to a failed drug test.
- d) The number of Police Officers and Police Staff who have been discharged from duty due to testing positive for AAS.

Our Occupational Health Department have provided the below data based on drugs testing completed when Professional Standards request a just cause.

2018 - 2 officers/staff tested, both negative.

2019 – 4 officers/staff tested, negative result.

2020 – 1 officer/staff tested, result returned positive but not for steroids – no further action was taken, the officer / member of staff resigned.

2021 - 1 officer/staff tested, negative result.

2022 up to date – 4 officers/staff tested – all negative.
