5 – Does the force have any active operations specifically designed to tackle racially aggravated crimes?

We have the Police Race Action Plan – which seeks to improve Policing responses to Hate Crime by;

- Reviewing our local policies, guidance and training delivery, to ensure that
 police personnel have the knowledge, training and understanding of how to
 deliver the most appropriate service to Black People who are victims of hate
 crime and their families.
- Continue to monitor nationally the number of hate crime incidents, criminal allegations and victim's satisfaction level and outcome rate.

In addition, our Football Unit work to combat hate crime including racially aggravated crimes. We have a dedicated hate crime investigations officer, this officer was the first to hold this post in the country and now used as a benchmark for good practice for other forces. Over the past football season, we received and investigated approximately 77 hate crime investigations which included 47 reports involving racial abuse.
