

We would like to formally put in a freedom of information request for the number of disturbances at:

- 1. Sikh Gurdwaras**
- 2. Hindu Mandirs**
- 3. Muslim Mosques**
- 4. Jewish Synagogues**
- 5. Churches**

We would like the data of each individual place of worship recorded separately from the date of 15 June 2022 to 15 June 2023.

We have conducted a search of our systems for the number of crimes recorded with a location marker for 'Church/Place of Worship'. However, please be advised that offences that occurred at a place of worship that did not have the 'Church/Place of Worship' location marker applied to them will not have been identified and are therefore not included in the results below. Location markers are used to denote a variety of circumstances such as offences that occurred at a venue or close to a venue (a location marker may be applied to a crime record because the venue is the nearest identifiable landmark for recording purposes). However, due to the low number of records retrieved using this location marker, we have conducted a subsequent manual review of each record to identify the type of venue. Please note some offence locations were not identifiable.

In addition, we have assessed the relevance of each record and can advise the below data may include offences that occurred inside or outside of the venue. Some records have also been excluded from the data below as they did not appear to relate to a place of worship (e.g. the offence occurred on the street near a place of worship).
