We have a 24/7 drone team that deploy to a variety of crime scenes, incidents, and events. This includes, but is not limited to: Crimes in progress, Missing person searches, Pre-planned sporting events, Protest/Disorder, Thermal task, Warrants/Arrest attempts, Training, and Public/Community events
